Thornbrook Surgery, a purpose built surgery, opened in 1992 required more consulting rooms, office space and a newly invigorated reception suitable for their growing practice and needs as a 21st Century facility for patients and a Training Practice.

Building Projects have created 5 new consulting rooms including all associated drainage, a new electrical lay out, marmoleum flooring, partitioning, ceilings and decoration.

A new records office has been created and the reception has been designed with a new functional yet aesthetically pleasing finish creating more space and light and a new bespoke reception desk finished in maple and aluminium, a modern but welcoming effect.

New offices have been created within the loft space for a new administrative Area, here structural steelwork was utilized for the strengthening that was necessary.
